Our final selection from Italy is the **Mezzacorona 2004 Chardonnay** from the Trentino region.

This fits the mould of classic Italian chardonnay which often lacks the power of hothouse California chards, but has its own distinctive, somewhat milder aromas and flavours.

Its citrus accents contrast well with many cream-sauced dishes.

Mezzacorona 2004 Chardonnay

Don't look for lush oak stylings as this refreshing sipper is vinified in mainly stainless steel tanks. Enticing aromas of lemon, lime peel, green apple and fresh sliced pear greet the nose.

The spicy apple flavours carry through to a crisp, dry finish with a twist of citrus essence lingering.
